Note from Pastor Henry

There have been some people who have predicted that the COVID-19 pandemic will spark a revival in the church. That is my hope, too.

Recently I came across an article in Decision magazine by Michael Youssef in which he tells about another pandemic which happened 249 A.D. to 262 A.D. That unknown disease was spread by the movement of the Roman army throughout the empire. At its height, the disease was killing up to 5,000 people a day in the city of Rome alone (and we had 3 deaths the other day in Winnipeg...)

As result of that pandemic, the Roman Emperor Decius required every citizen to make a sacrifice to the Roman gods, in an attempt to halt its spread. However, many Christians refused to make those pagan sacrifices and that triggered the so-called 'Decian Persecution'. Those who refused were blamed for the spread of the plague and were imprisoned or executed.

Some Christians yielded to the persecution and defected from the faith. But many others remained faithful unto death. However, the church in that day tremendously impacted the world for Christ. Because of the persecution, many believers were driven far from home and they shared the Gospel wherever they went. When they encountered sick and dying plague victims, they offered care and the Good News.

The pandemic came to be named the "Plague of Cyprian" for St. Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage, who encouraged the faithful during the pandemic. Encyclopedia Britannica writes, "Both the threat of imminent death from the plague and the unwavering conviction among many of the Christian clergy in the face of it won many converts to the faith."

As result, the Gospel of Jesus Christ spread all over the world and expanded the church into previously unreached corners of the empire.

So also today, we Christians must find ways to redeem the sufferings caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Let's ask God to use this event for His glory and for the spread of the Gospel. Let's boldly share the Good News of Jesus Christ with everyone we meet.

Yousef concludes, "While wearing our masks to prevent the spread of the virus, we can talk to our neighbors, doctors and grocery store clerks about Christ. We can share God's truth with people on Instagram and Facebook and Zoom. We can speak peace to their fears, and we can love them into the Kingdom of God."

May that indeed be the case.
